## CUP COMPETITIONS AND LEAGUE REGULATIONS

Norfolk Cup<br>(Senior/Junior Cups)

## In the event of a draw 10 minutes each way.

Replacements As per RFU Cup below i.e. 4 replacements/substitutes for the earlier rounds, 6 for later rounds (semi's and final).

## RFU National Clubs Knock Out Senior/Intermediate/Junior Eastern Counties Cup <br> In the event of a draw 10 minutes each way. <br> Replacements/Substitutes Maximum FOUR in attendance. <br> Teams (ie named squads) must have FIVE players capable of playing in front row. (Replacement front row can be either on bench or playing in another position). This covers injury or temporary suspension of front row forwards. <br> If a team on the first or second occasion says it has no front row forwards, you can go to uncontested scrums BUT the team without the required replacement forwards is deemed to have lost the match, (it follows that if there should be a third occasion, then the requirement for uncontested scrums does not lose them the match, as they have fulfilled their obligation in having two front row replacements). <br> THERE IS NO LEEWAY.

For the semi finals and final, maximum SIX in attendance, 5 players must be capable of playing in front row.

Leagues (Level 5 and below)

Not more than three replacements/substitutes.

## Front Row replacements

Squads must have FOUR players capable of playing in the front row.
On the second/subsequent occasions if there is no one capable of playing in the front row for an injured, temporally suspended, or a dismissed player, the match is abandoned for the purposes of the league result. The game however continues with uncontested scrums. (But please note the score, time elapsed and what was said to you, for the subsequent inquiry! However, do not make any comment to the teams as to the outcome of the
situation, as that is for the organising committee to decide.)
For temporary suspensions, however, that create the second or subsequent occurrence, uncontested scrums are allowed for the duration (only) of the suspension, and this has no bearing on the match result.
